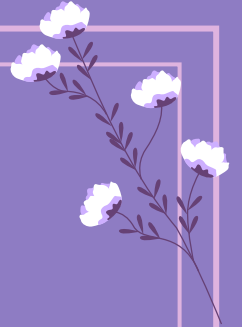

So... why is it important?

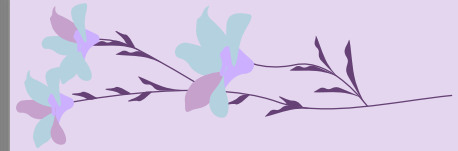

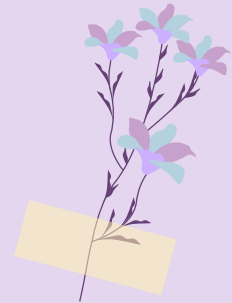
